The undersigned Det. A. Iversen – SOUTH JORDAN POLICE DEPARTMENT, Agency Case No. 09F009501, upon a written affidavit states on information and belief that the defendant, JOSHUA BUIE, committed the crime of:

COUNT 1

MURDER, 76-5-203 UCA, first degree felony, as follows: That on or about July 25, 2009 at 445 West 11400 South, in Salt Lake County, State of Utah the defendant

- (a) intentionally or knowingly caused the death of another; and/or
- (b) intending to cause serious bodily injury to another committed an act clearly dangerous to human life that caused the death of another; and/or
- (c) acting under circumstances evidencing a depraved indifference to human life engaged in conduct which created a grave risk of death to another and thereby caused the death of another; and/or
- (d) (i) while engaging in the commission, attempted commission, or immediate flight from the commission or attempted commission of a predicate offense, to wit: Discharge of a Firearm or a Dangerous Weapon, or was a party to the predicate offense; and
- (ii) a person other than the party as defined in Utah Code § 76-2-202 was killed in the course of the commission, attempted commission, or immediate flight from the commission or attempted commission of any predicate offense; and
- (iii) the defendant acted with the intent required as an element of the predicate offense.

AFFIDAVIT OF PROBABLE CAUSE:

This Information is based upon the following:

Your affiant, based on interviews of witnesses, and on information in report number 09F009501, hereby states the following.

On July 25, 2009, in Salt Lake County there was a gathering at the residence 113323 South Brook-N-Lance Drive. The Defendant, JOSHUA BUIE and the victim, Stephen Lasiloo were both present at that location. At that house, there was an argument involving multiple individuals including JOSHUA BUIE and Stephen Lasiloo about a stolen I-pod.

Witness, F.B. a juvenile, reported that Stephen Lasiloo then left on foot, accompanied by his sister, Janel Lasiloo, and his cousin, Christopher Clubfoot. F.B. also said that shortly after Stephen Lasiloo left with his relatives, JOSHUA BUIE left in a car driven by E.P. a juvenile. R.M. a juvenile was a passenger in the same car. E.P. and R.M. stated that as the car approached Stephen Lasiloo and his group, JOSHUA BUIE asked E.P. to stop the car. The car stopped at approximately 445 West 11400 South in Salt Lake County. Christopher Clubfoot and Janel Lasiloo stated that JOSHUA BUIE got out of the car and confronted Stephen Lasiloo; JOSHUA BUIE pointed a revolver at Stephen Lasiloo and shot the gun 3 or 4 times. Two of the shots hit Stephen Lasiloo who then fell to the ground with a gunshot wound in the chest. E.P. stated that JOSHUA BUIE got back in the car and said, "I did it. I popped that fool."

Dr. Christensen of the Office of the State of Utah Medical Examiner performed an autopsy on the body of Stephen Lasiloo and opined that Mr. Lasiloo died from a gunshot wound to the chest on July 25, 2009.
