Charges Filed Against Adrianna Lucero and Sergio Martinez-Gonzalez

SALT LAKE CITY – The Salt Lake County District Attorney's Office has charged Adrianna Lucero with one count of MURDER, a first degree felony, and two counts of CHILD ABUSE, both second degree felonies. The Salt Lake County District Attorney's Office has also charged Sergio Martinez-Gonzalez with OBSTRUCTION OF JUSTICE, a second degree felony. These charges stem from the events surrounding the death of Alejandro Lucero on August 24th, 2008. It is alleged that Adrianna Lucero caused serious injury to Alejandro, resulting in his death. It is also alleged that Ms. Lucero has caused physical injury to Alejandro on one or more prior occasions. It is alleged that Sergio Martinez-Gonzalez was aware that Alejandro suffered a serious injury on August 24th, but lied to police officers about the cause of the injury.

If convicted of the MURDER, Ms. Lucero faces a sentence of 15 years to life in prison. If convicted of CHILD ABUSE, Ms. Lucero could face a possible sentence of 1 to 15 years in prison.

If convicted of OBSTRUCTION OF JUSTICE, Mr. Martinez-Gonzalez could face a possible sentence of 1 to 15 years in prison.
